MEMBERSHIP RULES

SUMMER 2010

The following rules have been established to assure safe and sanitary operation of pool facilities. Parents are requested to caution their children to observe these rules. The Pool Management and lifeguards oversee the safe and sanitary operation of the pool and grounds and general conduct of members. Infractions of these rules may result in cancellation of membership or in suspension of pool privileges at the discretion of the Board of Governors.

Admission

- Normal swimming hours are from 12:00 noon until 8:45 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 1:00 p.m. until 8:45 p.m. Sunday. The pool opens full-time on the first day after Moorestown Public Schools close for the summer recess.
- Any of the pools may be closed, at any time, by the pool management for maintenance operations, health conditions, weather or lack of personnel.
- Each active member using the pool shall be listed in the computer database at the gatehouse. Each member is required to enter and exit the pool area via the gatehouse. Upon arriving to the swim club, members are required to stop at the gatehouse and sign-in.
- Guests will be admitted only when accompanied by an adult member of Sunnybrook Swim Club. After entering the pool area through the gatehouse, both guests and their sponsoring member must register at the gatehouse. Guest fees are either paid for at admittance or the member must present a guest pass. Members are responsible for their guests. When the sponsoring member leaves the Club, the guest must also leave.
- Caretakers/Nannies must be 13 years or older and they are required to have a sponsoring family. The sponsoring family is required to be an active member of the club. The sponsoring family is responsible for the \$50 annual nanny fee. Caretakers/Nannies 13 to 17 years old are not allowed to watch children under the age of 10 years old without a parent present at the pool
- Guest passes are available for purchase after May ^{2nd}, at the non-discounted rate of 15 visits for \$45.00 from the pool management. Guest passes expire at the end of each season and are non-refundable. Guest Passes may be purchased at the manager's office.
- Daily Guest Pass rates are as follows: \$5.00 any day before 6:00 p.m. and \$2.00 for any day after 6:00 p.m.
- A guest privilege shall not be issued to the same individual, regardless of sponsor, more than four times per month.

- Persons under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs will be denied entrance to the Swim Club.
- No child under ten years of age will be permitted to enter the Swim Club unless accompanied by one of his parents or a responsible adult.
- After 6:00 p.m. an adult must accompany all children under the age of 13.

Safety and Sanitation

- All members and guests must be clean before entering the pools.
- Persons suffering from communicable illnesses, communicable skin diseases, fungus infections, sore or inflamed eyes, excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts, bandages, nasal or ear discharges, eye, ear, nose, or throat infections are prohibited from using the pool or locker room facilities. The pool management will bar from the pool and locker room facilities any person(s) who, in management's opinion, exhibit evidence of any of the above.
- Expecting and blowing of nose in any of the pools is prohibited.
- No one is permitted in any pool unless a lifeguard is on duty.
- All injuries, however slight, must be reported to the pool management.
- Floating Devices are only permitted in the lower lap pool on Tuesday evenings from 6:00 pm until 8:00 pm. At no other time are floating devices permitted in the main pools, however, kickboards are available for instruction or lap swimming in the lower lap pool. Small inflatable rubber or plastic toys will be permitted in the baby pool only. No hard or sharp items (such as metal buckets or shovels) will be permitted.
- No running, ball throwing, pushing, wrestling, dunking, rough playing, etc. is permitted in the pools or on the pool decks.
- Sunnybrook Swim Club is a no smoking facility. No smoking is permitted on Sunnybrook Swim Club property. This includes, pool decks, bathrooms, grassy areas, and parking areas.
- Children (12 and under) may be permitted, unaccompanied, to enter the lower lap pool and use the diving board and slide only if they have passed a high band test. Children (12 and under) who have passed a low band test may only enter the lower end of the upper pool, unaccompanied. In the event that a child has not passed a band test, then he or she may be permitted to enter the lower lap pool and the lower end of the upper pool only when accompanied by a qualified swimmer who is at least 13 years of age. They may go off the diving board and or slide only if a qualified swimmer who is at least 13 years of age, is on the pool deck by the diving well and has made themselves known to the lifeguard on duty as the person responsible for the un-banded child. In the event a band is lost, a \$1.00 fee will be charged to replace the band. The swim band policy is posted throughout the Club.

- Non-qualified swimmers, regardless of age, will not be permitted to use the diving board or slide and are not permitted in the lower lap pool if they cannot stand with their head above the water.
- Diving will be allowed only off of the diving board. Only one person will be allowed on the diving board or in the diving well at a time.
- People who want to use the slide should form a line at the bottom of the slide steps. Only one person is to be on the slide stairs at a time.
- No general swimming in the diving well will be permitted at any time.
- A 15-minute Adult Swim period (for those 16 and older) will be called each hour at a quarter till the hour. The purpose of this is to give children under the age of 16 a 15-minute rest period each hour. During the Adult Swim periods, an adult may hold a child age 2 and under in their arms in the shallow end of the upper pool only. The last Adult Swim period for the day will be at 5:45 p.m. No children between the ages of 5 and 16 years of age are allowed in the baby pool during the 15 minute adult swim time.
- No one is permitted to be on the lane lines at any time.
- Use of the baby pool is restricted to children up to, and including the age of six (regardless of band status). No child is allowed inside the baby pool area without an accompanying adult. Children using the baby pool are the responsibility of their parents even though a lifeguard is on duty. There is no running allowed in the baby pool area.
- Babies MUST wear a diaper with plastic pants or a swim diaper and bathing suit in order to swim in the upper pool and/or the baby pool. Babies in diapers and/or who are untrained will not be permitted in the lower (lap) pool. Swim diapers are available at the Gatehouse. Are the diapers for sale for a fee?
- Chairs and chaise lounges are provided free on a first-come, first-serve basis. Saving or holding chairs or lounges for others will not be permitted.
- No throwing of coins, stones or other “retrieval game” items are allowed to be thrown into any of the pools.
- Radios will be permitted only if it does not disturb others.
- Pets are prohibited on club property.
- Private swim lessons are permitted if taught by a part-time and/or full-time employee of SBSC. They must be completed before 1:00 p.m. or start after 5 p.m. Participants must register with the manager prior to the lesson.
- The public address system shall be used only during swim meets and in no event shall be used prior to 9:00 a.m. during said meets. Starting systems of any kind may not be used at any other time or for any other purpose.

Food and Beverages

- Glass or glass containers are not allowed on the Swim Club property. This includes baby bottles, which must be plastic.
- No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be permitted on the Swim Club property at any time.
- All trash must be deposited in the trash receptacles and recyclables in their appropriate container.
- All foods and drinks are prohibited from consumption while a person is occupying any of the pools. Food and drink residue may not be washed off in any of the pools.

Responsibility

- The pool management will not be responsible for loss of any personal property in or about the Swim Club.
- All members, including children, using the Swim Club facilities do so at their own risk. The management will not be responsible for any accidents in connection with such use.
- Members and/or guests will be responsible for the cost of any damages caused through their negligence and/or carelessness. Members are responsible for any damages caused by their guests.
- Rental of the premises to any non-member groups or organization is prohibited.
- There shall be no club parking along the railroad easement right-of-way: No parking shall be provided for or allowed from the intersection of Devon Road and Covington Terrace and along the entire drive leading into the facility. There is no parking along the entire drive leading into and from the club facility.
- All suggestions or complaints should be made, in writing, signed and submitted, to the pool management or sent to: The Board of Governors, Sunnybrook Club, Inc., P.O. Box 91, Moorestown, NJ 08057
- All notices must be signed, dated and approved by the pool management before being posted. Any postings that are not signed will be taken down and disregarded.
- These rules may be revised or additional rules established at any time by the Rules Committee, subject to the approval by the Board of Governors.
